He is currently assigned by Cardinal Humberto Medieros to a "ministry for the gay and bisexual communities."

A former lecturer in clinical psychology in the Graduate School of Education at Harvard University, Fr. Shanley was also a former campus minister, at Boston State College.

The producer of two cessettes "Straight Talk about Gays" and "Counseling Parents of Gays," Fr. Shanley lectures entensively throughout the nation. A member of the American Association of Sex Educators and Counselors, he has also received numerous awards for his work in mental health including: The Mayor's Citizenship Citation in Boston, the Distinguished Service Award for "Lasting Contributions to the Community and the Nation: and a citation from the Eastern: Massachusetts Mental Health Association.

Accompanied by a team of dec tors, Fr. Shanley recently lectured throughout the Archdiccese: of Boston on sex education. He has been elected to the Boston Archdiocesan Senate of Priests for three terms.
